Main Function:

This role of GMP Production Scientist will report to the Production Manager and will be within the Production team responsible for delivery of Cellular Therapy Manufacturing Projects. The GMP Production Scientist will be responsible for performing production activities for the company's contract manufacturing operation to support the delivery of a range of cellular therapy products on a timely basis, meeting all the required quality and regulatory standards and developing the service in line with clinical and customer needs.

Specific Responsibilities:

- As a member of the Production team, performing the manufacture of Cellular Therapies and Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products (ATMPs) according to Good Manufacturing Practice within a controlled clean room environment
- Complete quality related documentation including batch production records, change controls, incidents/deviations and risk assessments in accordance with GMP and standard operating procedures
- Support with the daily Production housekeeping activities, including but not limited to cleaning, stock control and ordering materials
- Preparation and maintenance of Standard Operating Procedures
- Preparation of batch records, standard forms for batch manufacture
- Prepare formal documentation for new projects to enable developments to be introduced in a suitably controlled manner
- Ensure that confidentiality of all information relating to clients and patients is maintained at all times
- Communicate procedures and results with clients

- Demonstrate excellent customer service skills for both internal and external customers
- Plan and undertake the Validation of new Production processes and equipment
- Compliance with all Health and Safety policies and procedures
- Providing out of hours cover for critical equipment alarms as required on a rotational basis.
- Training of new starts/junior staff
- Routine qualification, calibration and maintenance of production equipment.

Qualifications Required:

The post holder will have a Life Sciences degree, or a degree in a related subject, or equivalent training and experience that includes cell culture.

Skills/Experience Required:

The ideal candidate will also have:

- Experience of working within a GMP clean room production environment
- A background in stem cells, cellular therapies or cell banking
- Effective communication skills in report writing/recording output, engaging with colleagues at all levels and professional liaison with customers
- A working knowledge of UK laws and regulations for cell therapy products and tissue donation
- Excellent computer skills with experience in Microsoft Word and Excel
